What we know

- Benadryl is a type of anticholinergic drug
- Studies show use of anticholinergic drugs is associated with dementia:
 - Among adults ages 50+
 - After long-term use(daily for 3+ years)

What we don't know

- Studies don't prove that these drugs cause dementia
- How these drugs affect those under age 50

Bottom Line

Benadryl may not be the best choice for longterm daily use

Always use medications as directed

Here are some alternatives to anticholinergic antihistamines like Benadryl:

- Claritin (Loratadine)
- Zyrtec (Cetirizine)
- Allegra (Fexofenadine)
- Clarinex (Desloratadine)
- Xyzal (Levocetirizine)
