What is "raw" milk?

Raw milk is not typically sold in stores. It has not been pasteurized to kill harmful bacteria and can carry germs and viruses like E. coli, salmonella, and now bird flu.

Can raw milk be harmful?

YES. Raw milk and products made from raw milk can cause serious illness, hospitalization, or death.
